BOONDALL OFF SITE ACTIVITY

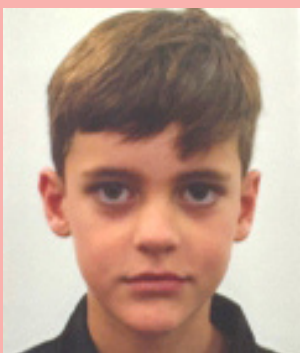
